## 2024 CURBSIDE LEAF COLLECTION PROGRAM

The City of Burlington Department of Public Works will begin this year's Curbside Fall Leaf Collection Program in November. Please read this notice carefully.

The leaf pickup zones correspond with your trash pickup schedule.

## **PROGRAM INFORMATION:**

- Rake leaves to the curb line for pickup. DO NOT bag leaves. City residents who want to bag their leaves can take bagged leaves to the Municipal Recycling Drop-off Center located at 850 Jacksonville Road (across from the Laurel Hill Cemetery). The drop-off center will be open on Wednesdays and Saturdays from 7:30 am to 2:30 pm during the Leaf Collection Program.
- The Department of Public Works will not be collecting curbside brush during the leaf collection program. Residents may take brush to the Municipal Drop-off Center on Wednesdays and Saturdays from 7:30 am to 2:30 pm. All brush dropped off at the drop-off center must be properly bundled: no branches can be in excess of 6 inches in diameter and no longer than 4 feet.
- Anyone leaving trash, brush, or leaves outside of the fenced area of the Municipal Recycling dropoff center during hours when the Center is closed will be subject to fines and penalties.
